TO AUTHORIZE THE PRESIDENT OF THE REPUBLIC TO RATIFY
CONVENTION No.155 CONCERNING OCCUPATIONAL SAFETY AND
HEALTH AND THE WORKING ENVIRONMENT, ADOPTED IN
GENEVA, SWITZERLAND, ON 22 JUNE 1981

*The National Assembly deliberated and
adopted, the President of the Republic
hereby enacts the set out below:*


SECTION 1: The President of the Republic is hereby authorized to ratify Convention No 155 concerning Occupational Safety and Health and the Working Environment of the International Labour Organization (ILO), adopted on 22 June 1981 in Geneva, Switzerland, at the 67th session of the International Labour Conference (ILC).

SECTION 2: This law shall be registered and published according to the procedure of urgency and inserted in the Official Gazette in English and French.
